



Directions to Loudoun County Public Library Branches

Ashburn Library

43316 Hay Rd, Ashburn, VA 20147 - Phone: 703-737-8100

From the East:

Take Route 7 west toward Leesburg. Take the right hand exit onto Claiborne Parkway south (Route 901) towards Belmont. At the fourth traffic light make a left onto Hay Road. The library will be on your left.

From the West:

Take Route 7 east toward Leesburg. Take the right hand exit onto Claiborne Parkway south (Route 901) towards Belmont. At the fourth traffic light make a left onto Hay Road. The library will be on your left.

From the South:

Take Belmont Ridge Road (Route 659) from Arcola and Aldie. Make a right onto Hay Rd and the library will be on your left past the traffic light at Hay Rd. and Claiborne Parkway.

From the North:

From Route 15 South take Route 7 east towards Tyson's Corner. Take the right hand exit onto Claiborne Parkway south (Route 901) towards Belmont. At the fourth traffic light make a left onto Hay Road. The library will be on your left.

Cascades Library

From the East:

Take Route 7 west, toward Leesburg. Exit onto Cascades Parkway North, (not south to Sterling). Turn right at the Home Depot onto Cranston Street. The library is 2 blocks ahead, directly in front of you. Parking is available at either end of the building.

From the West:

Follow Route 7 east, from Leesburg. After passing the Dulles Town Center Mall, watch for signs for Cascades Parkway. Take the second right exit, which is Cascades Parkway North (not South to Sterling). Turn right at the Home Depot onto Cranston Street. The library is 2 blocks in front of you. Parking is available at either end of the building.

From the South:

Take Route 28 North. Turn right on Route 7 East. After passing the Dulles Town Center Mall, watch for signs for Cascades Parkway. Take the second right exit, which is Cascades Parkway North (not South to Sterling). Turn right at the Home Depot onto Cranston Street. The library is 2 blocks in front of you. Parking is available at either end of the building.

From the North:

Take Potomac View to Palisades Parkway. Turn right onto Palisades Parkway. Turn left on to Whitfield Place. The library is between the Church and the Senior Center. Parking is available at either end of the building.

Lovettsville Library

From the East:

Take Route 7 west toward Purcellville/Winchester. Exit at Route 9 west toward Hillsboro/Charles Town. Turn right onto Route 287 north. Continue into Lovettsville. Turn right at Broad-Way (7-11 store). Turn left onto Light Street. The

library is at the end of the cul-de-sac.

From the West:

Take Route 7 east towards Leesburg. Exit onto Route 287 north towards Lovettsville. Cross Route 9 and continue north into Lovettsville. Turn right at Broad-Way (7-11 store). Turn left onto Light Street. The library is at the end of the cul-de-sac.

From the South:

From Route 7, take Route 287 north towards Lovettsville/Brunswick. Cross Route 9 and continue north into Lovettsville. Turn right at Broad-Way (7-11 store). Turn left onto Light Street. The library is at the end of the cul-de-sac.

From the North:

Take Virginia Route 287 south towards Lovettsville/Purcellville. Continue into Lovettsville and turn left at Broad-Way (7-11 store). Turn left onto Light Street. The library is at the end of the cul-de-sac.



Middleburg Library

From the East:

Take Route 50 west toward Winchester. Go through the commercial district in the center of Middleburg. Look for the large yellow stucco Community Center on the right and take the next right at the "library" sign onto Reed Street. The library is 1/2 block off Route 50.

From the West:

Take Route 50 east toward Washington DC. As you enter the Middleburg town limits look for the "library" sign on the right after several residential blocks. Turn left onto Reed Street. The library is 1/2 block off Route 50.

From the South:

Take Route 15 north to Gilbert's Corner. At the traffic light turn left on Route 50 West toward Winchester. Go through the commercial district of Middleburg. Look for the large yellow stucco Community Center on the right and take the next right at the "library" sign onto Reed Street. The library is 1/2 block off Route 50.

From the North:

From Route 7 in Purcellville, take Route 690 south to the flashing traffic light at Route 734. Continue on the same road, which is now Route 611 south. At the end of the road turn left onto Route 50 east. Go approximately 3 miles to the "library" sign on the right. Turn left onto Reed Street. The library is 1/2 block off Route 50.



Purcellville Library

From the East:

Take Route 7 west toward Winchester. Business Route 7 through Purcellville is Main Street. The library is about two blocks beyond the Loudoun Valley Shopping Center. The library is a stone building on the left - 220 East Main Street. Turn left onto DeSales Court to enter the parking lot at the rear of the building. The entrance to the building is on DeSales Court.

From the West:

Take Route 7 east toward Leesburg. Business Route 7 through Purcellville is Main Street. Pass through the traffic light at the center of town. The library is a stone building on the right - 220 East Main Street. Turn right on DeSales Court to enter the parking lot at the rear of the building. The entrance to the building is on DeSales Court.

From the South:

Take Route 611 north from Route 50. At the junction of Routes 734, 611, and 690, take 690 north. Follow it to Business Route 7 (Main Street). Turn right onto Main Street. Pass through the traffic light at the center of town. The library is a stone building on the right - 220 East Main Street. Turn right on DeSales Court to enter the parking lot at the rear of the building. The entrance to the building is on DeSales Court.

From the North:

Take Route 287 south to Business Route 7 (Main Street). Turn right on Business Route 7 at the T intersection. The library is about two blocks beyond the Loudoun Valley Shopping Center. The library is a stone building on the left - 220 East Main Street. Turn left onto DeSales Court to enter the parking lot at the rear of the building. The entrance to the building is on DeSales Court.

From the East:

Take Leesburg Pike/VA Route 7 West to the intersection with King Street (US Route 15). Turn right onto North King Street (US Route 15 N). Follow Route 15 North approximately one mile. Turn left at the sign for Ida Lee Recreation Center. Go past the recreation center and the library is on the left.

From the West:

Take VA Route 7 East towards Leesburg. Take the Route 7 BUS exit to Leesburg. Turn left onto Morven Park Rd. At the dead-end, turn right onto Old Waterford Rd NW. The library is approximately half a mile on the left.

From the South:

Take James Monroe Highway/US-15 North. Follow US-15 N through town. Turn left at the sign for Ida Lee Recreation Center. Go past the recreation center and the library is on the left.

From the North:

Follow US-15 South to Leesburg. Bear right and follow the signs for US-15 BUS/Leesburg. Continue to the sign for the Ida Lee Recreation Center and turn right. Go past the recreation center and the library is on the left.
