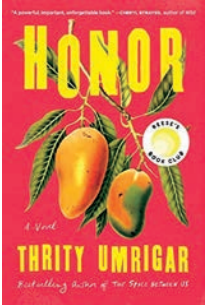
The Other Man

A young woman travels from the south of India to Kashmir in pursuit of a figure from her childhood.



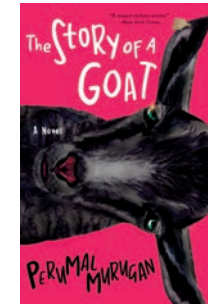
Honor

Journalist Smita returns to India to cover the story of Meena, who was attacked by her own village for marrying a Muslim man, and is drawn into an affair of her own.



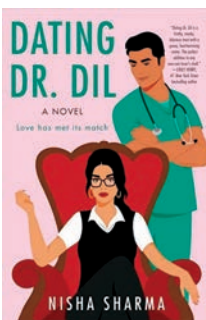
The Henna Artist
