Instructions

How to Enter

Email your entry to miranda.madro@loudoun.gov by 11:59 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 18.

Entries must include the following:

1. One photo of your cookie creation.
2. The name of your cookie creation.
3. Each person's name involved in baking, decorating and photographing your cookie creation.
4. What recipe(s) you used and where you accessed them. Specific ingredients/instructions are not required.

Entries will be judged on the following criteria:

1. **Name of Cookie Creation:** Imaginatively describe your creation's autumn theme.
2. **Creativity of Design:** Use different shapes, colors, decoration types and techniques to represent an autumn theme.
3. **Photo of Cookie Creation:** Take a high-quality photo of your cookie creation in an interesting arrangement.
4. **Use of Library-Provided Leaf:** Incorporate the leaf artistically into your autumn theme or design.

Rules

1. This competition is meant for adults and will be judged at an adult level, but participants are not required to provide their age.
2. You must bake the cookies yourself. You may use store-bought dough and icing, but you're encouraged to make your own.
3. Your cookie creation must have an autumn theme. This could include the changing of seasons, fall holidays, back-to-school or other events or items that remind you of autumn.
4. You can include any number of cookies in your photo, but you may only submit one photo of your cookie creation.
5. The library-provided leaf must be visible in your contest entry photo. Brambleton Bake Off leaves are available at Brambleton Library's 2nd Floor Service Desk starting Monday, Nov. 4.
6. Multiple people can help bake, decorate and photograph your cookie creation, but each person's name must be included on a single entry. Each of them will share the prize if your photo wins.
7. Your entry photo and cookie creation name must be appropriate for all ages.
8. LCPL has the right to use the information and photo from your entry on LCPL social media and other library materials.

Winners

Winners will be announced on Saturday, Nov. 23, at [facebook.com/BrambletonLibrary](https://www.facebook.com/BrambletonLibrary) and can pick up their baking-themed prizes at Brambleton Library's 1st Floor Service Desk. Prizes include a Brambleton Bake Off sublimation apron, created in the library's Makerspace.
